Sl.	Bidders Query	OMPL Replies/modification/clarifications/addendum
1	Clause No.A.20 (3) page no.14 of 54 & B.11 Note No. ii) page no.16 of 54 of Section-II of Tender documents: Working beyond normal working hours. Please provide the tentative hours for working beyond the normal working hours /days in entire duration of the contract and add the same in SOR to quote.	There may be maximum 6 (six) non-working days each of 8 hours in a year. Bidders are requested to take the same in account while quoting and please note that there shall no separate line item in the SOR for the same.
2	Any additional work on Holiday shall be only for manpower or equipments also?	Additional work on holidays, if any may involve both manpower and equipments.
3	Para 4 of page no.14 of 54 of Section-II of Tender documents: Since, where Workmen's Compensation is provided to workers, ESI shall not applicable, hence please clarify whether you require both or only one of the above.	From 1st May onwards OMPL is covered under ESI implemented area, employees with salary up to Rs. 15,000/- monthly is covered under ESI. Others may be covered as per applicable laws.
4	Clause No.B.4 page no.15 of 54 of Section-II of Tender documents: Unloading of loaded LCL/FCL Containers, de-stuffing of cargo, re-loading & transportation of empty Containers from one place to another place and unloading the same. This activity cannot be done by the equipments required in the contract, hence please remove the said activity from contractor's scope.	The required Equipment (not specified in the scope of contractor), for the said activity shall be provided by OMPL.
5	Clause No.11 page no.27 of 54 of Section-III of Tender documents: Warranty / Defect Liability. Please clarify that the clause is applicable or not to the subject contract since, the contract being a Service Contract.	Being a service contract, the subject clause of defect liability is not applicable.
6	PAGE 6 : BQC – "Completed single work contract of similar job for minimum order value of Rs.97,12,800/- in any of the past 5 years period ending last day of month previous to the month in which tender is invited". WILL A PROVISIONAL CERTIFICATE BE ACCEPTED AS QUALIFICATION CRITERIA?	In case of any ongoing contracts, Bidder to submit satisfactory performance certificate with minimum completed/executed value. Completed/Executed Value shall be equal to or more than the value (Rs. 97,12,800/-) specified in Bidder Qualification Criteria at Clause No. 6.A.i) on Page No. 6 of tender document.
7	PAGE 11: SCOPE OF WORK – Please Clarify items covered in packing materials to be supplied by contractor.	Packing Materials shall be provided by OMPL.
8	Specify nature of chemicals to be handled (Hazardous / Non-hazardous) and type of packing for chemicals.	Both Hazardous and Non-Hazardous materials need to be handled. Types of packing shall be carboys, drums & barrels of different sizes.
9	Any special registration required from Karnataka state for operating at the OMPL.	Bidder to check the requirement with the respective authorities for applicable registration/compliance and submit their quote accordingly.

10	In case of any local strike / hartal effecting manpower and equipment duty, any provision or regulation for exemption from fine or penalty? Ref 8.2 (A) bid document.	Tender conditions shall prevail.
11	Can the mobilization period of 10 days be extended?	Manpower to be mobilized within 10 days from the date of issue of LOA/Work Order. However equipments can be mobilized within 30 days from the date of issue of LOA/Work Order.
12	Any labour/local union problem effecting our work and scope of handling them.	Bidders/Contractor to manage the manpower deployment as per tender terms & conditions.

All other terms & conditions, stipulations, specifications etc. of tender document issued earlier shall remain unaltered. This forms an integral part of bidding document. Bidders are requested to take cognizance of the same and submit their bids accordingly. Bidders are requested to submit the copy of this document duly signed & stamped along with the bid (in the techno-commercial part) as the token of acknowledgement & acceptance of the same.
