



**Replies/Modification/Clarifications/Addendum dated 26-Apr-2016 to
Tender No. 1090C16014 dated 25-Mar-2016 for
Supply of Isomar Clay (133.70MT) and XFU/BTF Clay (212.98MT) for clay treaters to
ONGC Mangalore Petrochemicals Ltd (OMPL) - An SEZ Unit**

A</p>	<p>Delivery Period as per tender: <u>Isomar Clay (16FA02A and 16FA02B):</u> The entire quantity is to be supplied in 2 lots on a staggered delivery basis as advised by OMPL from time to time. Supplier to note that the entire delivery of the clay shall be completed within 8 months from the date of delivery of the first lot to OMPL, Mangalore. Supplier has to commence the shipment as per advice from OMPL starting with the first lot. Each lot of Clay should reach OMPL, Mangalore within two weeks of such request. Clay should be transported in approved jumbo bags that are sealed properly.</p> <p><u>XFU Clay (18FA02A and 18FA02B) and BTF Clay (14FA01A and 14FA01B):</u> The entire quantity is to be supplied in 2 lots on a staggered delivery basis as advised by OMPL from time to time. Supplier to note that the entire delivery of the clay shall be completed within 8 months from the date of delivery of the first lot to OMPL, Mangalore. Supplier has to commence the shipment as per advice from OMPL starting with the first lot. Each lot of Clay should reach OMPL, Mangalore within two weeks of such request. Clay should be transported in approved jumbo bags that are sealed properly.</p>	<p>Revised Delivery Period: <u>Isomar Clay (16FA02A and 16FA02B):</u> The entire quantity is to be supplied in 2 lots on a staggered delivery basis. Supplier to complete the delivery of first lot (50% of PO Qty. of line item no. I of price bid format) within 2 months from the date of Purchase Order and second lot (balance 50% of PO Qty. of line item no. I of price bid format) to be delivered within 8 months from the date of Purchase Order. Clay should be transported in jumbo bags that are sealed properly.</p> <p><u>XFU Clay (18FA02A and 18FA02B) and BTF Clay (14FA01A and 14FA01B):</u> The entire quantity is to be supplied in 2 lots on a staggered delivery basis. Supplier to complete the delivery of first lot (50% of PO Qty. of line item no. II of price bid format) within 2 months from the date of Purchase Order and second lot (balance 50% of PO Qty. of line item no. II of price bid format) to be delivered within 8 months from the date of Purchase Order. Clay should be transported in jumbo bags that are sealed properly.</p> <p>Supplier to ensure supply of Clay (Isomar Clay & XFU Clay) through Jumbo Bags that are sealed properly in Container/Truck. The Supplier needs to inform OMPL in advance of any special arrangements (if any) required at OMPL end (with drawings) during unloading from container/Truck at site. Containers/trucks will be released within 2 days from the date of receipt at OMPL site.</p>

Sale on High Sea Sale / Direct Import basis:</p>	<p>Option of executing the order on High Sea Sale/Direct Import (Foreign Bidders) basis is allowed and following points are to be complied: <u>For HSS basis:</u> i) Price & delivery basis shall be FOR OMPL Mangalore site basis. ii) Custom clearance from the port of landing and further transportation & insurance of the materials from the port till OMPL site shall be carried out by supplier on behalf of OMPL. The charges (excluding Service tax)</p>

towards the custom clearance & further inland transportation till OMPL site is to be indicated separately in price schedule and same shall be paid by OMPL.

OMPL being SEZ unit, Custom Duty is nil and Service Tax is exempted against Form A1 & A2. OMPL shall provide necessary SEZ certificate/documents to avail such exemption and shall facilitate the bidder in creating the necessary authorizations in filing the on line BOE (Bill of entry) with office of the Authorized officer, MSEZ, Mangalore. No Sales tax would be applicable as the sale is being made on High Seas.

iii) Payment Terms shall remain same as per tender document.

For direct import basis:

- i) Price & delivery basis shall be on CIF Mangalore/Indian port of entry basis (Incoterm 2010).
- ii) Custom clearance from the port of landing and further transportation & insurance of the materials from the port till OMPL site shall be carried out by OMPL through CHA.
- iii) For evaluation purpose, the quoted prices shall be loaded for custom clearance & transportation from port to OMPL site as per price available with OMPL.
- iv) Payment terms as: 90% payment against irrevocable Letter of Credit (LC) with a credit period of 30 days from the date of Bill of Lading/Airway Bill through any Indian Nationalized / Scheduled Bank as advised by OMPL. Balance 10% shall be released through TT against receipt & acceptance of the total material at OMPL site. All banking charges in supplier's country (outside India) to suppliers account and inside India to OMPL account. Supplier shall submit the following shipping documents to the bank for release of final payment through L/C.

- a Duly signed 3 original commercial invoice mentioning itemized rates, quantity, item description as per PO
- b 3 Original Packing list
- c Bill of Lading/Airway bill
- d 2 Original Fumigation certificate (In case equipment is packed in wooden case)
- e Original certificate of origin issued by Chamber of Commerce.
- f Original manufacturer's test certificate/Certificate of Analysis to be produced for technical bid evaluation.

		g Guarantee/Warranty certificate of the material. The shelf life of the clay should be atleast one year from the manufacturing date
D	Queries regarding supply quantity: Supplies of material in 10 tons per FCL, so requested the quantities be rounded off to multiple of 10 tons.	Not acceptable, since it will affect the loading qty. at clay treater of OMPL.
E	Queries regarding tender fee: Request to remove the tender fee of INR 2000	Tender Fee of INR 2000 shall be applicable as per tender document. In case of Foreign Bidder, Bidder may submit the Tender fee in USD 35 by way of Bank Draft/ Bankers Cheque from any International Bank having branch in India and registered with Reserve Bank of India as scheduled foreign bank, in favour of "ONGC Mangalore Petrochemicals Limited", payable at Mangalore, Karnataka, India.
F	Queries regarding EMD and Security Deposit as: Bidder believes EMD and Security Deposit are one and the same. If these are separate, then bidder requested that Security Deposit be removed for this tender.	Tender terms and conditions related to EMD and Security deposit shall prevail. However incase successful bidder wants to submit single Bank Guarantee towards security deposit and Performance Bank Guarantee then it should be of 10% of the quoted value valid till the guarantee/warranty period of material as per clause no. 11 of GCC with a claim period of 02 (two) months. For Foreign bidders, EMD of USD 2585 (Isomar Clay) and USD 4120 (XFU BTF Clay) shall be submitted in the form of DD/BG issued by any International Bank having branch in India and registered with Reserve Bank of India as scheduled foreign bank.
G	Clarification w.r.t. guarantee the performance of clay: Bidder requested to clarify if OMPL wants the bidder to guarantee the performance of the clay (life of clay) and whether it will be for 12 months as per clause 11 of GCC.	The shelf life of the clay should be atleast one year from the manufacturing date. Performance guarantee of clay will as per tender specification.
All other terms & conditions, stipulations, specifications etc. of tender document issued earlier shall remain unaltered. Bidders are requested to take these modification/additions/deletions while submitting their offers.
